## ATTENTION 6<sup>TH</sup> GRADE PARENTS

An additional immunization is required by the Department of Health and the Department of Education for **all students entering the 7<sup>th</sup> grade next school year.**

A Tdap booster (adult strength tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis) is required before your child can begin the school year 2009-10 unless a booster dose has been received within the past five years and the school has documentation of the student receiving the earlier booster dose.

Formal documentation is mandated. You must present a completed blue Florida Certificate of Immunization form DH 680, with an updated Part A signed by a healthcare provider or designee, for your child to receive a schedule or enter school on the first day of the school year.

Please submit the proper proof of immunization to your child's school as soon as possible.

Your child's healthcare provider or the Seminole County Health Department can provide the Tdap booster. The Health Department is located at the following addresses:
